If a title only is received by the closing date, or if the abstract sent exceeds the space allowed, the communication may be given, but only the title will be published in the Society's Proceedings.

An International Conference on Diabetes in the Tropics will be held in Bombay from 20th to 22nd January, 1966. The deliberations of the Conference will be in English.

The following aspects of Tropical Diabetes will be discussed:—

1. Incidence of diabetes, its mortality and morbidity in the tropics.

2. Diabetes in the young.
3. Pancreatic diabetes.
4. Diet with particular reference to high carbohydrate content in diabetes in the tropics.
5. Complications of diabetes and their prevention.
6. Management of diabetes in the tropics.
7. Prevention of diabetes.

The Conference is open to all the workers in the field of diabetes whether they are members of the Diabetic Association or not, provided that their paper is accepted by the Organising Committee.

Abstracts of papers along with the title of the article and the names of all the authors should reach the Organising Secretary by 15th October 1965, and the full text of the article along with the list of references by 1st January 1966. Arrangements can be made to project 35 mm. slides and 16 mm. films if prior intimation is given when submitting the paper. Time allotted to each paper including that for films and slides shall not exceed 10 minutes.
