*VIIIth International Congress of Nutrition—
Hamburg, 1966 (August)*

The Society has a small sum of money set aside to assist members in travelling to the Congress. Preference will be given to young members who should write giving details of their age, present post, together with an undertaking that no financial support is available from any other sources.

Drummond Annual Prize, 1966

The Drummond Trustees have made available a prize of £250 awarded for work in the field of nutrition. The Council of the British Nutrition Society and the Trustees have agreed that the prize shall be open to competition amongst people who have not reached the age of 35 by the closing date. The prize is for research undertaken by persons normally resident in the U.K., although work submitted may have been done overseas.

Submissions should normally consist of the candidate's published work or papers accepted for publication. Two complete sets of such papers should be submitted with a letter of application to Mr. D. S. Miller, Hon. Secretary, Nutrition Society, Queen Elizabeth College, London, W.8. The closing date for the award is January 31, 1966.
