“The FIRST CONGRESS of the South East Asia and PACIFIC AREA LEAGUE (SEAPAL) AGAINST RHEUMATISM

This Congress would be held in Bombay, from Saturday February 17 to Wednesday, February 21, 1968. The SEAPAL was the latest to be affiliated to the International League Against Rheumatism (at the XIth International Congress of Rheumatology held at Mar del Plata, Argentina, in December 1965). Some of the aspects which would be discussed at the Congress would touch special points in regard to rheumatic diseases in the Tropics.

The member nations of the SEAPAL are the national Rheumatism Associations of Australia, India, Japan, New Zealand and the Philippines. It is expected that a large number of doctors in the South East Asia and Pacific region would attend. The organisers of the Congress would welcome the participation of doctors from all countries, who have an interest in this area of
