The vacancies in Surgery include General Surgery, Thoracic Surgery and Neuro Surgery. Whilst appointments for twelve months in these specialities are preferred, rotations of six months may possibly be arranged.

Appointments in the other specialities are for 12 months, but rotations of six months may possibly be arranged.
