Dear Sir,

May I draw your attention to certain inaccuracies in the paper "A study of 136 cases of General Paralysis of the insane in a mental hospital" by Drs. Chia and Tsoi—S.M.J. 12:5 1971

It is erroneous to group Taboparesis with the other "clinical syndromes" as in Table IV. Taboparesis and General paresis of the Insane are related forms of neurosyphilis and the "clinical syndromes" are but mental manifestations of both General Paralysis of the Insane and Taboparesis.

The paper conveys the impression that absent or sluggish tendon jerks is a feature of GPI. Table V showed that at least 25 cases (of 85 recorded cases) had absent or sluggish tendon jerks. GPI per se shows exaggerated tendon jerks and "if any of the tendon jerks are absent it is because of the presence of an element of Tabes Dorsalis" \*.

Hence there could not have been only 2 cases of Taboparesis (Table IV) in the 136 patients.
