This excellent little book by a nursing sister who is also a physiotherapist fills a gap in the orthopaedic library of any department dealing with the locomotor system. Even the experienced orthopaedic surgeon will find this book informative. It is invaluable to those who have to teach: both at undergraduate as well as at postgraduate levels.

It ought to be digested by all doctors who work in orthopaedic departments and

"prescribe" splints and appliances that take time to make and often cost a lot: a fact that may be forgotten by those ordering them.

Wisely, Miss Kennedy has avoided the details of splint and appliance making which is best left to those trained in prosthetics and orthotics.
