DIFFERENTIAL DIAGNOSES OF TALL R WAVE IN V1

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CASE HISTORY




Fig 1 - 12 lead electrocardiogram of the patient at the Accident and Emergency department

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

The fit lasted for 30 seconds and was over by the time he was brought to the resuscitation room. The 12 lead ECG which was done after the fit is shown in Fig 1.
